Also required of all students who were enrolled at SBCC before Fall 2007, stopped attending for one semester or more, and return to SBCC in Fall 2007 or after to complete degree requirements. Exception: Information Competency is required effective Summer 2006 for Liberal Studies majors.
 - F: ENG 120 OR LIBR 101 with a Pass (P) satisfies this requirement
