	<b>CSU GRADUATION REQUIREMENT IN U.S. HISTORY, CONSTITUTION AND AMERICAN IDEALS</b> This requirement may be met before or after transfer to the CSU. At the discretion of the CSU campus granting the degree, courses meeting this requirement may also be counted toward certification in general education. Students satisfy this CSU graduation requirement through coursework in three areas: US-1, US-2 and US-3. A student must take one course from each of the three areas. A student may use the same course to satisfy more than one area (US-1, US-2, US-3), if applicable. <b>Note:</b> The combination of SBCC's History 101 and 102 (or 102H) may also satisfy this requirement but ONLY if both courses were completed before Fall 2004. <b>US – 1: Historical Development of American Institutions &amp; Ideals:</b> BLST 102 (before Fall 04); HIST 100 (before Spring 15),105HR (before Fall 03), 114 (before Fall 19),114H (before Fall 19),116 (before Spring 15) <b>US – 2: U.S. Constitution and Government:</b> POLS 106H (before Fall 04) <b>US – 3: U.S. California State and Local Government:</b> POLS 106H (before Fall 04)
